C. Randy Hutchinson became senior vice president of business development for Entergy Nuclear in January 2000. In recognition of the increasing scope of work, new plant activities were incorporated into his formal title in February 2007. His responsibilities include overseeing strategic and tactical elements of new business development in Entergy's nuclear growth program, designed to sustain Entergy Nuclear's position as one of a few successful nuclear operators remaining as the electricity industry is reshaped by deregulation and market forces. Hutchinson has overseen successful completion in 2007 of an early site permit application for a possible new nuclear unit at the Grand Gulf site in Mississippi. He fostered Entergy's leadership in the creation of NuStart consortium to participate in the U.S. Department of Energy's Nuclear Power 2010 program and to test new licensing processes established by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission including early site permits and combined construction and operating license applications.

Hutchinson brings more than 35 years of nuclear experience to his role. In his previous assignment, he was site vice president at Arkansas Nuclear One, Russellville, Ark., for three years. He had earlier held the same position at Grand Gulf Nuclear Station, Port Gibson, Miss., while the station achieved three consecutive superior SALP ratings from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and other industry performance distinctions.

Hutchinson joined Entergy in June 1973 during the early stages of Grand Gulf's construction. From his initial role as a support services superintendent, he advanced quickly into management positions, becoming general manager of the station in 1985, with those responsibilities until he was promoted to vice president in 1993.

The nuclear industry has benefited from Hutchinson's leadership. He has served on the Academy Council for the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations, the Nuclear Energy Institute's Strategic Issues Advisory

Committee, the Babcock and Wilcox Owner's Group Executive Committee, and other working groups and committees.

Hutchinson earned a bachelor of science degree in electronic engineering from Mississippi State University. He worked in the Ingalls Shipbuilding Nuclear Submarine Program in Pascagoula, Miss., for five years prior to joining Entergy. He has been certified as a senior reactor operator and has completed executive management programs at INPO, the Southeastern Electric Exchange, and The University of Michigan.
